Krakow expressed concern about ex-officio representative, Todd Gokey, as of today he has not attended any meetings. Corpe has talked to him and he is interested but is very busy. Gokey has copies of all the minutes up to today. Rohn commented that he could be more active when the interviews began.

An informal meeting of this committee met Wednesday, November 23, to discuss the type of letters we would send out to New Urbanism (NU) applicants. There was a lot of discussion on the wordage. Letter A would address the applicants interviewing with the committee. Letter B would say "thank you but no thank you to" applicants. Krakow and Krause had different views on the financial information. Krause felt cost should be discussed in the early stages of the process. Krakow maintained the Board would work out the financial details. Firms that will receive Letter A are RTKL, UDA and Wade Trim. Letter B will go to the following firms: Johnson Hill Land Ethics, Nederveld and Valle & Valle.

Krakow reviewed update on the timeline. Responses to be considered must be at the township on or before December 5, 2005. Oral presentations will be scheduled during the week of December 19-23, 2005.

Rohn emailed the funding research results. Corpe and Rohn will begin looking into the funding available.
