John Iacoangeli, from Beckett & Raeder, was introduced to committee members. Iacoangeli has been chosen to do the update on the Parks & Recreation Plan. Iacoangeli said he was happy to be selected and was looking for input today from the two committees. In order to receive DNR funding in April the township must have the current Parks & Recreation Plan updated every five years. We want to have a draft by January 28th. There will be a thirty day review. Iacoangeli reported that we have about six weeks to pull information together.

Iacoangeli handed out the Capital Improvement Schedule from the previous Parks & Recreation Plan for Acme Township recreation facilities. The committees went through and made comments about what has or has not been done.

Iacoangeli suggested putting together a survey that would be on our township website asking for public input. Knopf, Sherberneau and Salathiel will work on draft questions for the survey. They will email to Iacoangeli their results.

There will be a community input meeting on January 16, 2008. Iacoangeli said the meeting would last about two hours. Salathiel will look into possible places to hold meeting.
