C. Old Business:

1. Begin Phase II of Boat Launch Preliminiary Design on Sayler Park

Upon selection of the preferred site, Sayler Park, we are now ready for the next task in the development of the location, Wade, said. The following tasks will be required for the site development phase; Boundary and topographic survey for the parcel and surrounding parcels; depth soundings of the bottomlands for the boat launch area; Illustration of the spatial requirements for buildings, parking, boat launch, playground, beach area and fish cleaning station and wave attenuation design to name a few.

There was a lengthy discussion on how to do the boat launch with a variety of opinions offered. Everyone desires to maintain the character of the area.. Drawings were handed out showing different styles. An email from Brink was also passed out. He too wants to preserve the tranquility of the area..

2. Parks and Recreation Plan Receive and File

Committee members received bound copies of the Acme Township Parks System Plan for 2008-2013.

2. Playgrounds – Tom Henkel

Committee members were given a playgound project packet by Henkel. The materials were prepared to aid in a plan for renovating our playgrounds. The materials included; the laws governing playground equipment; the standards; the need for safety, pictures of the current equipment, information on grants. Henkel went through the packet pointing out points of interest. There is playground equipment that needs replacing for insurance purposes and safety.

Sherberneau suggested the committee take a tour of the parks so that they can get a feel of what needs to be done. It was decided to meet, Thursday, May 8th, at 7:00 pm at Sayler Park and then meet at 7:45 pm at Bayside.

3. Discuss 2008-09 fiscal year Budget requests.

Vreeland asked the committee if they had any budget requests for the 2008-09 fiscal year. No one could think of anything to budget for. Vreeland said you don't have to have one. You can always do an amendment to the budget if a need arises in the fiscal year.
