Glen Cavanaugh, 10387 Kay Ray Road, asked if purchasing the marina was to make money. Aukerman commented that we apply for grants, receive money, build the facilities with the end result being revenues coming back to the township. She talked about the history of Elk Rapids Marina and how everything now is a profit.

Cavanaugh asked if another restaurant could come in. Vreeland commented that it was possible but if the township acquires the property using a Department of Natural Resources Trust fund grant we will be required to demolish the building.
